# CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. LURA MORGAN

of Bandon, State of Oregon, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
said Stream  
a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of  
Supplemental Domestic  
under Permit No. 14346 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from March 17, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.05 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected on T. Lowe D.L.C. No. 37,  
Section 1, Township 29 South, Range 15 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second  
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  HW $\frac{1}{4}$ ),  
Section 1,  
T. 29 S., R. 15 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described  
by appropriator as follows:

Commencing at the Meander Post between Section 36, T. 28 S. R. 15 W. W. M., and  
Section 1, T. 29 S. R. 15 W. W. M., which post is an iron pipe with brass cap marked  
M. C. S 1 S 36; thence East 24.6 ft. to an  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch pipe post in the Western boundary  
of the Thompson Lowe Donation Land Claim; thence South 442.9 ft. to a buried boulder,  
the South West corner of said Donation Land Claim; thence along the South boundary  
said Claim N. 89 degrees 36 minutes E. 211.3 ft to an  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch pipe post in the center  
of the County Road from which a spruce 14 inches in dia. marked A P C S 183 B T bears  
S. 63 degrees E. distant 73.8 ft.; thence along the center of said County Road S. 1  
degree 40 minutes E. 591.6 ft to an  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch pipe post. from which a spruce 12 inches  
in dia. marked A P C S-183 B T bears S. 17 degrees 55 minutes W. distant 194.7 ft.;  
thence S. 89 degrees 36 minutes W. and at 158.0 ft. passing through an  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch pipe  
post and continue on same course a total distance of 298.0 feet more or less to the  
ordinary high water mark of the Pacific Ocean; thence along said high water mark  
approximately N. 6 degrees 47 minutes W. 404.5 ft.; thence along said high water  
mark approximately N. 11 degrees 30 minutes E. 218.0 ft.; thence along said high water  
mark approximately North 420.2 ft.; thence East 50.0 ft. more or less to the place of  
beginning, containing 5.116 acres.

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Water under this right is to compensate for any deficiency that may occur in the supply appropriated under certificate No. 13769, and the water to be appropriated under this right and under certificate No. 13769 shall not exceed a total of 0.05 cubic foot per second.

THIS RIGHT REMAINS UNRESTRICTED
