**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify,** That RAY A. AND MARGUERITE M. WINEGAR

of Star Route, Marcola, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mohawk River a tributary of McKenzie River, for the purpose of Irrigation, Domestic and Stock, being 0.038 c.f.s. for irrigation & 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic and stock, under Permit No. 14863 & 13534 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 12, 1941 and March 22, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.043 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected on B. H. Allen D.L.C. 39, Section 18, Township 16 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the B. H. Allen D.L.C. #39 in Section 18 township 16 South of Range 1 West of Willamette Meridian in Layne Count Ore and Run North North 2.92 chains thence East 2.89 chains thence South 2.92 chains then west 2.89

chains to the Place of beginning all in Said Sect. 18 TP. 16 S. R. of 1 W. of W. M. Leyne Co. Ore.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Donation Land Claim No 39, Notf No. 7179 in Township Sixteen (16) South Range One (1) West of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence North 2.92 chains, thence East 2.89 chains, thence South 3.77 chains, thence Northeasterly along the center of the County Road to a point 7.05 chains, thence West 8.25 chains to the center of the Mohawk River, thence Southwesterly down the center of said River to a point 2.13 chains west of the Beginning point, and thence East to the place of beginning, containing 4.97 acres, more or less, in Lane County, Ore.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
