## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That. L. J. REED

, has made proof Leland State of Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Flume Gulch

a tributary of 'Grave Creek for the purpose of

under Permit No. 15105 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 22, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 SE4, Section 33, Township 33 South, Range 6 West,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 42 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 3 acres in the NEE NWL, 13 acres in the NW NET, Section 4, T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W. M. 4 acres in the SE SW., Section 33, T. 33 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
