CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PHILIP R. AND LUELLE L. TROMBLY

of Harbor _____, State of Oregon _____, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Unnamed Spring _____
a tributary of _____ for the purpose of
Domestic _____

under Permit No. 15233 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from March 23, 1942

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
100 gallons per day,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 4, Township 41 South,
Range 13 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$),
Section 4,
T. 41 S., R. 13 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described
by appropriator as follows: Starting from the Southwest corner of the J.G. Benson
property which is located in the S.E. Quarter of the S.W. Quarter of Section 4, Town-
ship 41 South, Range 13 West Willamette Meridian, running North 375.4 feet to point
of beginning, thence North 185 feet, thence 10 degrees North of East, a distance of
235.5 feet, thence South 185 feet, thence 10 degrees South of West 235.5 feet to the
point of beginning, containing one acre, more or less, and all lying and being in
Curry County, State of Oregon, subject to existing water pipe right of way.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
