CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK B. SOLOMON

of Elkton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Lower Stony Brook, a tributary of Umpqua River, for the purpose of Domestic Supply for Camp under Permit No. 15274, of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 18, 1942

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 4, Township 22 South, Range 8 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected on D.L.C. No. 49,
Section 5,
T. 22 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a one inch by 48 in iron pipe driven in the ground at a fence corner on the south right of way line of the Umpqua Hi-way from which the angle in the south boundary of the Andrew Sawyers D.L.C. No. 49 T.w.p. 22 S range 8 W.M. bears S 40°39' W 1703 ft, and from which an oak tree 28 inches in diameter bears S 77°55' E 322 ft, and an oak tree 28 inches in diameter bears, N 69°34' E 567.3 ft along the right of way line of the Umpqua Hi-way thence S 20°26' E 20.0 feet along said right of way line thence N 20°26' W. 20.0 feet along said right of way line; thence N 69°34' E 1012 feet along said right of way line; thence N 69°56' E 22.0 feet around at 1°30' curve right along said right of way line to its intersection with the East Boundary of the said Andrew Sawyers D.L.C. No. 49; thence S 41°E50 feet along said D.L.C. line to the meander line of the right bank of the Umpqua River; thence S 59°28' W. 1818 feet along the meander line of the Umpqua River; Thence N24°55' W 367 feet to the place of beginning containing 8.5 acres more or less being a tract of land lying between the Umpqua Hi-way and the Umpqua River and joining the East boundary of Andrew Sawyers D.L.C. No 49 in section 5 Township 22 South, rang 8 West, Willamette Meridian in Douglas Co. Oregon.
