CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RAY SPENCER

of Gold Hill, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of A spring a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of Domestic including the irrigation of a garden not exceeding $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area. under Permit No. 15468 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 3, 1942

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 15,
T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point which is 2122 feet South and 1565 feet West of the East one quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) corner of Section 15, Twp. 36 S., Range 3 W. W. M., thence running west along the southerly line of the City of Gold Hill property 181.4 feet, thence South 19 deg. west 106 feet, thence South 9 deg. West 137 feet, thence East 312 feet to the westerly right of way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad, thence Northerly along said right-of-way line to the point of beginning. Containing 1 and $\frac{1}{4}$ acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
