CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HAROLD A. MAHNKE, SR.

of 606 E. Acacia St., Glendale, L.A., State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Paint Creek and Delta Creek a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of Mining from Paint Creek and Domestic, including the irrigation of $\frac{1}{2}$ A. garden, From Delta Creek being 2.00 c.f.s. for mining and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic, under permit No. 15584 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 16, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, Township 35 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and $\frac{1}{2}$ acre garden in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Mining in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Mining in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 6,
T. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point four hundred and forty feet in a northwesterly direction from Delta and Paint Creek on the North bank of the Rogue River; thence thirteen hundred and twenty feet southeast to stake number two (2) on the north bank of the Rogue River; thence six hundred and sixty feet Northeast to stake number three (3); thence thirteen hundred and twenty feet Northwest to stake number four (4); thence six hundred and sixty feet southwest to stake number one (1), and located in Section number Six (6), Township number Thirty Five (35) South, Range Seven (7) West, Willamette Meridian.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
