CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE J. THOMAS, JESSIE K. THOMAS, ROUTE 1, BOX 102, ROSEBURG, HARRY THOMAS, LESTER THOMAS, WILLIAM THOMAS, VIOLA CRAWFORD, NELLIE OLSON, of Roseburg, State of Oregon, ROUTE 1, BOX 101-A, has a right to the use of

the waters of Roberts Creek

for the purpose of stock and domestic

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Douglas County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 13, at page 467; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed enough for 20 cattle, 5 horses, 6 hogs, 7 sheep, 1,600 turkeys and domestic

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

NW 1/4 (less 1.12 acres) & SW 1/4, Section 16, S 1/2 SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 17, T. 28 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
