CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. A. AND NELLIE HARRIS

of Gaston, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Harris Creek
for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Washington County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 613; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1907

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre measured at the point of diversion from the stream, and the total quantity diverted shall not exceed two and one-half acre feet per acre during the irrigation season from May 1 to October 1 of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$,
3 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 30,
T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
