CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That William A. Gray

of Route 5, Box 158, Salem, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Unnamed trib. of Beaver Creek

for the purpose of Domestic including irrigation of not to exceed 0.5 acre garden,
and stock use.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 357; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1866.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per
second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.5 acre, domestic and
stock use within that
portion of the follow-
ing described tract ly-
ing within Section 23,
T. 8 S., R. 2 W., W. M.
and being a portion of
Lot 22, Waldo Hills
Fruit Farms #3, Marion
County, Oregon:

Beginning at the NE corner of said Lot 22; thence south along the east line thereof
30.89 chains to a stone in the Salem and Aumsville County Road; thence N. 59° 45'
west 16.82 chains along said County road; thence north 22.42 chains to the north
line of said Lot 22; thence east along said north line 14.53 chains to the place
of beginning, and containing 38.71 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
