CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Otto Höven

of Route 6, Box 59, Salem, Oregon, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Unnamed stream, trib. to Mill Creek
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 357; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1908;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed be governed by the
provisions of the stipulation appearing in Paragraph 60 and the duty and head of
water fixed in Paragraph 115 of said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

7.5 acres in Sec. 6,
T. 8 S., R. 2 W., W.M.
being within the fol-
lowing described
tract:

Beginning on the south line of the Donation Land Claim of Benjamin Munkers and
wife 23.96 chains South 80° 25' West from the southeast corner of said claim,
said point being a stone in the County road leading from Salem to the Asylum Farm
in Township 8 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County,
Oregon; thence North 10° 45' East 0.44 chains to an iron pipe in the middle of
the County road; thence South 62° 15' East 12.0 chains to an iron pipe; thence
South 66° 30' West 43.30 chains to the South line of Joseph Bartoez; thence North
84° 45' West 2.54 chains to the middle of Mill Creek; thence down the middle of
the main channel of Mill Creek to the South line of the Donation Land Claim of
Benjamin Munkers; thence North 79° 20' East 37 chains to the place of beginning,
containing Fifty (50) acres of land, more or less, in Marion County, Oregon.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
