A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Within Section 35, and Section 36, T. 8 S., R. 3 W., W.M., being within the following described tract:

Beginning 10.37 chains S. 89° 24' E. from the SW corner of Sec. 36, T. 8 S., R. 3 W., W. M., in Marion County, Oregon; thence N. 25' W. 27.18 chains; thence N. 89° 24' W. 22.18 chains to the center of the Pacific Highway; thence N. 27° 47' E. along the center of said highway 3.57 chains; thence S. 89° 24' E. 30.20 chains; thence S. 56' E. 10.33 chains; thence S. 7' E. 20.0 chains; thence N. 89° 24' W. 9.67 chains to the point of beginning in Sections 35 and 36 in T. 8 S., R. 3 W., Marion County, Oregon.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
