CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Mike Nietling

of Route 1, Scio, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Unnamed spring and unnamed stream, trib. to Beaver Creek
for the purpose of Stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 357; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1870;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per
second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Within Section 27
and Section 34,
T. 8 S., R. 1 W., W.M.
in James D. Brown
D. L. C. NO. 21,
being within the
following described
tract;

Beginning at a point 16.67 chains East and 18 chains North of the Southwest corner
of D. L. C. No. 21 of James D. Brown, in Marion County, Oregon, and running thence
due East 22.58 chains; thence North 12 chains; thence East 75 links, thence North
3.25 chains; thence West 3.25 chains; thence South 3.25 chains; thence West 20.08
chains; thence South 12 chains to the place of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
