## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** State of Oregon by Oregon State Board  
of Control  
of Salem, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Mill Creek  
for the purpose of (see below)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 357; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from (see below)

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed (see below)

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,  
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

A right to the use of 230 cubic feet per second of the waters of Mill Creek for  
the development of 313.64 theoretical horse power with a date of priority of  
1865, the place of use being described as follows: Power Claim # 52

A right to the use of 1,615,562 gallons of water per 24 hours which includes

grounds, and State Capitol buildings and grounds with a date of priority of  
1865, the place of use being described as follows:

A right to the use of 304 gallons of water per minute from Mill Creek for domestic, stock and operation and maintenance of buildings and grounds at the State Tuberculosis Hospital and the State Penitentiary Annex, with a date of priority of 1891; the place of use being described as follows:

A right for the irrigation of 7.0 acres from Mill Creek with a date of priority of 1891, the quantity of water to which such right is entitled shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of said decree. The place of use for irrigation being described as follows:

*And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
