## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** John A. Smith and Charles E. Smith

of Route 5, Box 155, Salem, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Unnamed Spring, trib. to Beaver Creek  
for the purpose of Stock Use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 357; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1864;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per  
second;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,  
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Within the following  
described tract:

Beginning at the NW corner of the Henry Smith D. L. C. No. 38, Section 24, T 8 S.,  
R. 2 W., W. M., and running thence South 23.16 chains; thence East to the center  
of the County road; thence S. 10° East 0.29 chain; thence N. 87° East to a point  
due south of the re-entrant corner of the Henry Smith D. L. C. No. 38; thence  
North to said re-entrant corner; thence continuing North and West along the  
boundary line of said Henry Smith D. L. C. to the place of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
