CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That G. H. Toelle

of Route 1, Box 270, Stayton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Mill Creek Cremer Branch, and Spring in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 2, T. 9 S., R. 1 W., W. M.; for the purpose of Stock use;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 357; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1857;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

In Section 1, and Section 2,
T. 9 S., R. 1 W., W. M.
being within the
following described
tract:

Beginning at the center of Sec. 1, T. 9 S., R. 1 W., W. M., running thence North 17 rods; thence West 160 rods; thence South 60 rods, thence West 160 rods; thence South 117 rods; thence East 320 rods; thence North 160 rods to the place of beginning, EXCEPTING the following: Commencing at a point on the quarter-section line 26 chains north of the quarter post on the south side of Section 2, T. 9 S., R. 1 W., W. M., thence East 2 chains; thence South 5 chains; thence West 2 chains; thence North 5 chains. All in Marion County, Oregon

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
