## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That C. M. Case

of Mehama, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Morehouse Creek

for the purpose of Domestic, irrigation, operation of ram and stock;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 354; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880; for domestic, irrigation and operation of ram; and shall be subject to the provisions of Paragraph 165 of said decree for stock use with no diversions;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.012 cubic foot per second for domestic and irrigation and operation of ram, and the amount of water for stock use shall be subject to the provisions of Paragraph 165 of said decree;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Domestic, irrigation and operation of ram:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
