CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Oregon Pulp & Paper Company, The Thomas Kay Woolen Mills Company, and City of Salem, Oregon of Salem, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of North Santiam River for the purpose of Power and Manufacturing

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 354; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1856;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 254.0 cubic feet per second;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Within the corporate limits of the City of Salem, Oregon

Power Claim # 63 & 68A

Change in use of 60 cfs - Sp. Or. Vol. 7, 1, 238 B. 1178 Amended Cert. 14,901 superseded by Certs, 19800 + 19801

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
