of North Powder State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River

for the purpose of the irrigation of $406\frac{1}{2}$ acres of land and domestic and stock use:

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 252; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1888 for the irrigation of 150 acres, and 1890 for 2562 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 10.16 sec. ft. from March 1st to July 1st and 5.08 sec. ft. from July 1st to October 1st of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 1,016 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 160 acres in NW4 of Section Thirty-five (35): 80 acres in N½ of NE4; 38 acres in SW4 of NE4; 30 acres in SE of NE4; 19 acres in NE2 of SW4; 38 acres in NW2 of SW4; 25 acres in SW4 of SE4; 11 acres in NE3 of SE4; Section Thirty-four (34), Township Six (6) South, Range Thirty-nine (39) East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
