and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the International of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at page 252; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1864 for the irrigation of $42\frac{1}{2}$ acres, and from 1894 for 100 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 3.56 sec. ft. from March 1st to July 1st and 1.78 sec. ft. from July 1st to October 1st of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 356 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 7 acres in NE₄ of NE₅; 4 acres in SW₄ of NE₄; 4 acres in NW₅ of SE₅; 23 acres in NE₄ of SE₅; 12 acres in SW₄ of SE₅; 3 acres in SE₅ of SE₅; Section Thirty-two (32), Township Siz (6) South, Range Thirty-eight (38): 20 acres in SE₅ of SW₅; Section Fourteen (14), 80 acres in N₅ of NW₅, Section Twenty-three (23), Township Seven (7) South, Range Thirty-eight (38) all East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
