CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Louis Flog

of Hood River, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Odell Creek for the purpose of Irrigation and power

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 6, at page 200; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1887;

irrigation purposes that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation, and that the total quantity diverted during the irrigation season shall not exceed three acre feet per acre, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Place of use for irrigation:

2 1/2 in 1/4 of diversion Spec. Or. V. 12 p. 320

11 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 7 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 14 T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

Place of use for power:

CANCELLED SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 14 T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M. CANCELLED Spec. Or. V. 12 p. 320

The right to the use of water for the development of power is limited to 0.5 cubic foot per second.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
