## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That

has a right to the use of

the waters of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 400 acres of land and domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Island of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 252; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1887 for the irrigation of 104 acres, from 1890 for 290 acres and from 1904 for six acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of ten sec. ft. from March 1st to July 1st and five sec. ft. from July 1st to October 1st; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 1000 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 20 acres in NE4 of NE4; 40 acres in NV4 of NE4; 13 acres in SW2 of NE4; 9 acres in SE4 of NE4; 80 acres in E2 of NV4; 38 acres in NW4 of NV4; 38 acres in NW4 of SW4; Section of NV4; 38 acres in SW2 of NW4; 40 acres in NE4 of SW2; 38 acres in NW4 of SW4; Section E4 acres in SE2 of SE4; Section Seven [7], Township Seven [7] South, Range Thirty-nine (39) East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.
