for the purpose of the irrigation of 822 acres of land and domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State W-ATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 252; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1869

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesuid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 2.06 sec. ft. from March 1st to July 1st and 1.03 sec. ft. from July 1st to October 1st of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 206 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is us follows: 5 acres in SW2 of SE2; Section Twenty-six (26(, 40 acres in NW2 of NE2; 372 acres in NE2 of NW2; Section Thirty-five (35) Township Six (6) South, Range Thirty-eight (38) East of Willamette Meridian, in Union County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
