CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That V. L. STEWARD

of Route 1, Box 123, Brooks, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pudding River, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 13375 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 30, 1938

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second for irrigation,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.2 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected on D.L.C. 56
Section 8
T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at an iron bar in the center of the County Road 8.994 chains S. 47° 14' W. from the re-entrant corner on the W. side of the R. D. Johnson D.L.C. in T. 6 S., R. 1 W. of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon; thence S. 51° 56' E. 6.531 chains to a point in the center line of Pudding River; thence running up said river S. 28° E. 6.20 chains; thence leaving said river and running N. 68° 17' W. 11.654 chains to a point in the center line of the County Road; thence running along said center line N. 22° 30' E. 2.927 chains; thence N. 33° 38' E. 2.984 chains to the point of beginning, containing 4.312 acres, more or less. Reserving across the above described land a road one rod wide along the way now being used near the West side of this tract.

Beginning at an iron pin in the re-entrant corner on the W. side of the R. D. Johnson D.L.C. in T. 6 S., R. 1 W. of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon; said iron pin being in the center line of the County Road; thence along said center line S. 47° 14' W. 8.994 chains to an iron bar; thence S. 33° 38' W. 2.984 chains to an iron bolt; thence S. 22° 30' W. 7.427 chains to an iron bar in an angle of said center line, which said bar marks the initial point of survey of the tract herein described; thence along the center line of said County Road

N. 22° 30' E. 4.50 chains to a copper pipe; thence leaving said County Road and running S. 68° 17' E. 11.654 chains to a point in the center line of Pudding River; thence running up said river S. 47° E. 15.70 chains; thence S. 7° W. 2.60 chains; thence S. 88° W. 2.10 chains; thence N. 46° W. 10.20 chains; thence N. 58° W. 6.10 chains; thence leaving said river and running N. 70° 39' W. 9.65 chains to the point of beginning; containing 10.67 acres of land, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
