CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. SILAS TORVEND

of Route 2, Silverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pudding River a tributary of Molalla River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 14181 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 30, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the any point on ~~my~~ ^{the} property where Pudding River touches it in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.7 acres in Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
1.1 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 42
6.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 43
Section 29
T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point in the east line of the David H. Smith D.L.C. No. 42 in T. 6 S. R. 1 W. of W.M. 4.00 chains north 12° 15' E. of the most westerly southwest corner of D.L.C. of Elias Cox, being Claim No. 43 in T. 6 S. R. 1 W. of W.M.; thence N. 12° 15' E. on said east line, 14.85 chains in the middle of the road; thence N. 33° 30' W. 2.41 chains in the middle of the road; thence N. 60° W. 2.58 chains in the middle of the road; thence N. 16° 15' W. 4.01 chains in the middle of the road; thence N. 48° 30' W. 2.31 chains in the middle of the road; Thence N. 33° 45' W. 1.81 chains in the middle of the road; thence N. 4° 45' E. 4.38 chains in the middle of the road; thence N. 44° 15' E. 5.66 chains in the middle of the road; thence N. 27° 45' E. 1.57 chains; thence N. 10° 30' E. 1.10 chains; thence N. 15° 45' W. 1.46 chains; thence N. 15° 30' E. 1.06 chains to line between sections 20 and 29, T. 6 S. R. 1 W. of W.M. 22.59 chains easterly from corner of sections 19, 20, 29, 30; thence easterly on said line 8.33 chains to the middle of Pudding River; thence following middle line of said river up stream to point N. 89° E. of the beginning point; thence S. 89° W. 11.34 chains to the place of beginning, containing 47-3/4 acres of land, more or less, situated in Marion County, Oregon.

Subject, however, to right-of-way forditches, canals and reservoir sites for irrigation purposes, constructed, or which may be constructed, by authority of the United States or otherwise, which right-of-way is hereby expressly reserved.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
