CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RUSSELL KOPPLIN

of Route 2, Gaston, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 14194 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 26, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 9.0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 42
7.2 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 42

T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Second tract: Being that part of the Donation Land Claim of Almorán Hill and wife, Claim No. 57 in T. 2 S. R. 4 W. and Claim No. 42 in T. 2 S. R. 3 West Will. Mer., bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a stone in the County Road running northerly and southerly through said claim, said stone being on the south boundary line of said claim and distant 32.47 chains from the southeast corner of said claim, said stone being the southwest corner of a tract of land deeded by said Almorán Hill and wife to M. H. Lowry running thence N 5° 12' West 13.05 chains to a stone; thence west 30.17 chains to a stone; thence 13 chains to a stone on said south boundary line of claim; thence east on such line 31.36 chains to the place of beginning, containing 40 acres, more or less. Save and except a certain piece as follows, to-wit:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
