CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That V. H. THOMPSON

of Dayton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Stream a tributary of Palmer Creek for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 14271 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 30, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 7.4 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Carney Goodrich D.L.C. 49 Section 21
- 3.8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Carney Goodrich D.L.C. 49 Section 20
- T. 4 S., R. 3 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Part of the Carney Goodrich Donation Land Claim, Notification No. 1040, Claim No. 49 in T. 4 S. R. 3 W. of the Willamette Meridian in the County of Yamhill and State of Oregon and said part bounded and described as follows to-wit: Beginning at a post set 68.66 chains West of the Southeast corner of said Donation Land Claim, said post being also at the Southwest corner of the "Hatfield 110 acre tract;" thence North 27.50 chains to the Northwest corner of said "Hatfield tract"; thence West 12.13 chains to West boundary line of lands now owned by said Grantors; thence South 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 13.10 chains to angle in said line; thence South 15.79 chains to South line of said Donation Land Claim above named; thence East 15.18 chains to the place of beginning and containing 41.37 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
