CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That C.S. MORGAN

of 1835 S. W. 2nd Ave., Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of An Unnamed Spring a tributary of Tillamook Bay for the purpose of under Permit No. 14573 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 13, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 20, Township 1 North, Range 10 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic use in Lot 4 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 20
T. 1 N., R. 10 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

All that part of the east half of Tract No. 18, in Section 20, Township one North of Range Ten West of Willamette Meridian which lies north of the County road. Said tract is described as beginning at a point 34 links south and 324 links west of the meander corner between Sections 20 and 21 township one north range Ten west, being 50 feet east of a small Creek emptying into Tillamook Bay thence North to North line of D. D. Bayley's preemption Claim thence West along said North line to a stake at Northeast corner of J. J. Handley tract thence south to Tillamook Bay thence easterly to beginning containing five acres, more or less, less R. R. Right of way and State Highway.

Also all of that part of the west half of Tract No. 19 in Section 20, Township one north of range ten west of Willamette Meridian which lies north of the county road. Said tract is described as beginning at a point on ordinary high water line 34 links south and 321 links west of meander corner between sections 20 and 21 Township one north range ten west, thence north 84° east 3.02 chains on ordinary high water line. Thence north 16.53 chains, thence west 3 chains thence south 16.84 chains to beginning, containing five acres more or less being the S. M. Bayley's five acre tract less R. R. right of way and State Highway.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
