CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That IRA MUILENBURG

of Route 1, Beaverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualetin River

atributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

Irrigation

under Permit No. 14802 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from Merch 14, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.53 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NET NWT S. SWT NWT, Section 13, NET SET SET NET, Section 14, Township 2 South, Renge 2 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shell be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

13.3 acres in the NE NN 1

7.4 acres in the NW 1

11.3 acres in the SW 1

0.2 acre in Lot 6 (SE 1 NW 1

Section 13,

0.1 acre in Lot 1 (NE 1 NE 1

8.9 acres in the SE 1 NE 1

1.2 acres in the NE 2 SE 1

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Part of the SE SW of Sec. 12 Twp 2 S $\rm Rn_5$ 2 W W.M. and part of $\rm NW_4^1$ of Sec. 13 T. 2 S $\rm Rng$ 2 W. W.M. and part of the $\rm E_2^1\rm E_2^1\rm E_2^1$ of Sec. 14 T. 2 S. R. 2 W. W.M. particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point in N line of said Sec. 14, 10 chains W of NW corner of Sec. 13, running thence E on N line of said Sections 13 and 14 30 chains to a stake; thence N. 2.50 chains more or less to SE corner of Thomas D. Humphreys DLC; thence S 58° 45' E to a stake on N. bank of Tualatin River and 25 links more or less from a white fir; thence S. 58° 45' E. to center of Tualatin River; thence up center of main channel of said river to W line of said section 13; thence S. on said W. section line to $\rm W_1^4$ corner of said section; thence W. 10 chains; thence N. 40 chains to place of beginning.

Also part of SE NE and part of NiNE SE particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point 10 chains W. and 119 rods 5 feet S of NE corner of Sec. 14,

thence W to center of Tualatin River; thence down center of said river to a point about 56 rods 8 feet S. of place of beginning; thence N. to place of beginning.

Also part of E2SE particularly described as follows: Lying N. of center of main channel of Tualatin River and E. of W. line of land deeded by sheriff of County (Book 52 page 77).

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
