CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That s. J. HOOVER & SON

of Independence , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River

a tributary of Columbia River Irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 14903 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 7, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.67 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE_4^+ NE_4^+ Section 21 and SW_4^+ NW_4^+ , Section 22, Township 8 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

26.0 acres in the NE NE as projected on D.L.C. 43
12.6 acres in the NW NE as projected on D.L.C. 43
Section 21
15.0 acres in the NW NW as projected on D.L.C. 43
Section 22
T. 8 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

40 acres off of the North side of the following described tract to-wit: beginning at the S. W. corner of the land deeded by Thomas Burbank and wife to Edwin Merwin, situated in T. 8 S., R. 4 of the Willamette Meridian in Polk County, Oregon, thence running East 37.50 chains, thence North 23 chains, thence West 25.50 chains to the N.E. corner of the land deeded to Robert S. Middleham by Edwin Merwin and wife, thence South 11.90 chains, to the S.E. corner of said land, thence West 15.25 chains to the center of the County road, thence South 12° 15' East 12.00 chains to the place of beginning, containing 73.10 acres said 40 acres to be cut therefrom by a due East and west line.

Also beginning at a point 49 chains East of the S.W. corner of the D.L.C. of Thomas L. Burbank and wife, in T. 8 S., R. 4 W., of the Willamette Meridian, running thence East 28.40 chains to the center of the County road thence North 12° 15' West 7.68 chains, thence West 26.83 chains, thence South 7.51 chains to the place of beginning containing 20.70 acres save and except a parcel of land owned by the Southern Pacific R. R. Co., running through said premises containing 70/100 of an acre.

Also another tract of land beginning 8.85 chains West of the S.E. corner of said Thomas L. Burbank and wife D.L.C. oforesaid and running thence North 22.58 chains, thence West 4.43 chains, thence 22.58 chains, thence East 4.43 chains to the place of beginning containing 10 acres save and except 2 acres off of the South end of said tract of land.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
