**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** M. J. SAUER

of P. O. Box 31, Kerby, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Henderson Creek a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of

Irrigation under Permit No. 15504 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 1, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.58 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 28, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 8.0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$

21.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 33

T. 38 S., R. 8 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Donation Land Claim #37, run South 1120 feet to the center of Reeves Creek; thence down creek North 83° West 721.3 feet; South 87° 30' West 492 feet; South 75° West 200 feet; South 7° West 350 feet; North 35° 30' West 115 feet; North 76° West 387 feet South 35° 30' West 330 feet; West 270 feet to center of Illinois River; down center of river to intersect the North line of Section 33; thence East 1680 feet to beginning, less road and river, in Section 33, Township 38 South, Range 8 West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, containing 46.8 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
