**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**        SYBIL BROWN

of 333 NE Halsey St., Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of An Unnamed Stream a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of Operation of Ram, Stock, and Domestic, including the irrigation of  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre garden under Permit No. 15589 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 23, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.033 cubic foot per second, being 0.03 c.f.s. for ram and 0.003 c.f.s. for stock and domestic.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWSE as projected, Section 35, Township 3 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

A part of the John S. Smith and wife Donation Land Claim Numbers 61 and 79 in Townships 3 and 4 South, Range 2 West; all of Lots 4 and 5 and part of Lot 6 of Section 35, Township 3 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of said John S. Smith and Wife Donation Land Claim on the left bank of the Willamette River; thence North along the west line of said claim 73.63 chains to the Northeast corner of the Michel La Fromboise Donation Land Claim; thence North 59° 45' West 26 chains to the intersection of the North line of said Section 35; thence along said north line south 89° 55' east 36.60 chains to the Northwest corner of "Tract #4" which is a basalt stone 9x8x7 inches marked L4 on east and L5 on west faces and + on top from which a fir 16 inches in diameter bears south 48° 30' east 52 links and a fir 18 inches in diameter bears south 37° 55' west 83 links; thence south 6° 3' east 67.31 chains to a point from which an iron bar driven in the ground near spring bears south 6° 3' east 472 links; thence south 12° 15' west 13 chains to a granite stone 14x9x7 inches marked + on top set on the North line of Section 2, Township 4 South, Range 2 West at a point 5.64 chains west of the Northeast corner thereof; thence south 5.10 chains to the left bank of the Willamette River; thence with the meanders of said left bank upstream North 60° west 4.49 chains; thence West 10 chains; thence South 60° West 5.07 chains to the place of beginning and containing 167.69 acres, more

or less, and being the same land conveyed to The Union Central Life Insurance Company by Deed dated May 31, 1938, and recorded in Book 114, Page 296, of the Records of Yamhill County, Oregon.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
