CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, that EARL T. WHITE

of Box 34, Jacksonville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Gulch a tributary of Little Applegate, a tributary of Big Applegate for the purpose of Domestic, including the irrigation of not to exceed 2 acre domestic gardens under Permit No. 16447 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 26, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW NET, Section 27, Township 39 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to — — — of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic & ½ acre garden in the E2NW4NE4 Section 27 T. 39 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Mining claim registered in Volume 35, Page 98, Jackson County Clerk's office. Quit claim deed registered from John Maeder to Earl T. White et ux May 3, 1937, as follows: The east half of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 27, Township 39 South, Range 2 West, Willemette Meridian; Correction to deed executed May 17, 1935, recorded in Volume 32, Page 529.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
