CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HENRY PEYRON AND HOLLAND LAND COMPANY

of Baker, State of Oregon 97814, has a right to the use of

the waters of Powder River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 384; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from March, 1905;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic Foot per second per acre;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

12 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36, Tp. 8 S., R. 40 E., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
