**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** O. L. WATERMAN

of 421 Evelyn Ave., Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Springs and Waterman Reservoir to be constructed under Permit No. R-829 a tributary of East Fork Illinois River for the purpose of Domestic, Stock, Fish and Lily Pond under Permit No. 16624 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 8, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic, 0.01 c.f.s. for stock, and 0.18 c.f.s. for fish and lily pond

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 31, Township 39 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer:

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
