CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. WARREN COREY

of Route 1, Cornelius, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Stream and Unnamed Spring a tributary of Dairy Creek for the purpose of Irrigation, Domestic and Stock under Permit No. 13312 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 7, 1938

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.51 cubic foot per second, being 0.5 c.f.s. from Stream for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. from Spring for domestic and stock,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26, Township 2 North, Range 3 West, W. M., as projected on Flemming Dobbins D.L.C. 43 from unnamed stream, and Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 23, Township 2 North, Range 3 West, W.M. from Spring.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion at the stream of not to exceed one acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any 30-day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion at the stream of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Flemming Dobbins D.L.C. 43

Domestic and stock in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Flemming Dobbins D.L.C. 43
1.2 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Flemming Dobbins D.L.C. 43
10.1 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Flemming Dobbins D.L.C. 43
5.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Flemming Dobbins D.L.C. 43
2.0 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Flemming Dobbins D.L.C. 43
Section 26,
0.8 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Flemming Dobbins D.L.C. 43
Section 27,
T. 2 N., R. 3 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Situate in the County of Washington, State of Oregon, to-wit: Beginning at an iron the northwest corner of the Fleming Dobbins Cl. No. 43, in Section 22, Township 2 North Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, Washington County, Oregon, thence on the north line of said Cl. North 83° 56' East 1755.6 feet to an iron, the northeast corner of the said Dobbins Cl., in the County Road; thence on the east line of claim south 3995 feet to an iron; thence south 81° 56' west 1490.5 feet more or less; to a point in the center line of the east fork of Dairy Creek said point being north 81° 56' East 110 feet, more or less, from an iron at the common corner of F. Pearl, Frank and J. Warren Corey tracts;

thence in the center line of said creek in a northwesterly direction following the meanderings of the same 2000 feet, more or less, to an intersection with the west line of the said Dobbins Cl., said point being north 0° 16' West 1111.8 feet, more or less, from the re-entrant corner on the west line of the Dobbins Cl., thence on the west line of said Dobbins Co., north 0° 16' west 2714.6 feet to the place of beginning, containing 156.8 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
