CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GLEN I. TALLY AND NORMAN E. MAYFIELD

of Rogue River, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Stream a tributary of East Fork of Evans Creek, tributary of Evans Creek for the purpose of Domestic, including the irrigation of a garden not exceeding $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area under Permit No. 15167 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 17, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, Township 33 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LEONARD SEIFER

of Rt. 1, Box 119, Brooks, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pudding River, a tributary of Molalla River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 15184 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 16, 1942

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.74 cubic foot per second;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 16 and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ AND SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 17, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.3 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected on Bluford Miller D.L.C.
- 2.6 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected on Bluford Miller D.L.C.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

All that part of the Donation Land Claim which is known in the Surveys of the United States as Notification No. 530 of the Heirs at Law of Bluford Miller, Deceased, which is on the South and West sides of Pudding River, making the center of said River the line between the lands hereby conveyed and the remainder of said Donation Land Claim, and containing 100.00 acres of land, more or less, situated in Marion County, Oregon.

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Claim No. 56 Notification No. 400 in Township 6 South Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, State of Oregon; thence East 46.75 chains, and to the middle of Pudding River; thence North $47^{\circ} 30'$ West 10 chains; thence North $22^{\circ} 30'$ West 4.50 chains; thence North 2.75 chains; thence North $23^{\circ} 30'$ West 2.50 chains; thence North $32^{\circ} 30'$ West 3.00 chains; thence North $40^{\circ} 30'$ West 5.39 chains; thence West 31.56 chains; thence South 23.03 chains to the place of beginning and containing 87.08 acres of land, more or less, and situate in the County of Marion, State of Oregon.
