**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** **ERMINA E. GILLETTE**

of Selma, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Six Mile Creek a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of Domestic, including irrigation of not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre domestic garden and mining, under Permit No. 16557 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 29, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.80 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.78 c.f.s. for mining.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2, Township 38 South, Range 9 West, W. M.,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
Section 2,  
T. 38 S., R. 9 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Twenty (20) acres of placer mining ground, situate in the Illinois River Mining District, Josephine County, Oregon, and more explicitly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the west end of the Six Mile Placer Claim 300 feet down Illinois River from Six Mile Creek Bridge in Section 2, Township 38, Meridian Range 9, commencing at the Southwest corner No. 1 on the North side of the Illinois River; thence 660 feet North to the Northwest corner No. 2; thence East 620 feet to Northeast corner No. 3; thence 660 feet South to Southeast corner No. 4; thence 620 feet West to Southwest corner No. 1 the place of beginning. Commencing at the east end center of the 660 foot strip corner No. 1; thence 660 feet east to Corner No. 2; thence 700 feet South to corner No. 3; thence 660 feet west to corner No. 4; thence 700 feet North to corner No. 1 to place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
