**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** ED N. BASIE

of Takilma, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of East Fork Illinois River a tributary of Illinois River, tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of Domestic under Permit No. 15665 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 20, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 10, Township 41 South,  
Range 8 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 10  
T. 41 S., R. 8 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southeast one quarter of Section 10 in Township 41 South Range 8 West of the Willamette Meridian in Oregon; thence running South 675 feet; thence East 225 feet; thence South 685 feet to the center of a bridge over Long Gulch; thence Southwesterly along the center line of Long Gulch 670 feet more or less to a point which is 200 feet West and 820 feet North of the Southwest corner of the Southeast one quarter of said Section 10; thence South 820 feet to the South line of Section 10; thence East 1520 feet to the Southeast corner of the Southwest one quarter of the Southeast one quarter of said Section 10; thence North 2640 feet; thence West 1320 feet to the place of beginning, containing 80 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
