CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED MIDDLEBUSH

of Prospect, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Mill Creek, a tributary of North Fork Rogue River, tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of

Domestic, including the irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre domestic garden under Permit No. 15821 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 14, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 29, Township 32 South, Range 3 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 32 T. 32 S., R. 3 E., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Starting 10 rods west of the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 32, Township 32 South, Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian; running thence South 40 rods; thence west 30 rods; thence north 9 1/2 rods; starting at this point, run east 6 rods; thence north 6 rods; thence west 6 rods; thence south 6 rods to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
