## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That . THEODORE HILTON TURNER

of Rt. 1, Box 192, Grants Pass , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Turner Spring a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic, including the irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre domestic garden. under Permit No. 16094 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from Incember 11, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW2 NE4, Section 24, Township 36 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE4 NW4, Section 24, T. 36 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: The North half of the Northwest quarter and the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 24 (24) in Township Thirty-six (36) South of Range Five (5) West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, containing one hundred twenty (120) acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
