CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That THELMA A. COYLE AND HENRY COYLE

of Azalea, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Gulch a tributary of Starveout Creek for the purpose of

Domestic under Permit No. 16450 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 27, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 Section 18, Township 32 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 Section 18 T. 32 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point 1150 feet south of the quarter corner between Sections 7 and 18 Township 32 South, Range 4 West of W.M. and at a point in the center of the Starvout Creek Road; thence South 418 feet; thence in a westerly direction along a line parallel with a line down the center of Starvout Creek Road 418 feet; thence north 418 feet; thence in an easterly direction along a line down the center of Starvout Creek Road 418 feet to the place of beginning, containing four (4) acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
