CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 68

of Vida, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a Spring a tributary of Gate Creek for the purpose of

Domestic under Permit No. 9598 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 4, 1930;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

T. 16 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

This certificate is to correct and supersede that certain water right certificate issued by the State Engineer on February 27, 1934, to School District #137, which certificate is recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates Volume 10, page 10657, so as to correctly describe the diversion point, place of use, quantity of water and name of appropriator.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Snow Creek Irrigation District

of Bend, State of Oregon, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Little Three Creek Lake and Big Three Creek Lake, tributaries of Three Creek

for the purposes of Irrigation and supplemental irrigation, to be appropriated under Applications No. 8852 and No. 8853, Permit No. 12458.

under Reservoir Permit No. 701 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 8, 1923 for 1400 acre-feet and September 12, 1936 for 200 acre-feet;

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 1600 acre-feet, being 200 acre-feet in Little Three Creek Lake Reservoir and 1400 acre feet in Big Three Creek Lake Reservoir. The reservoir is located in Section 14 and 15, Tp. 17 S., R. 9 E., W.M.
