CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courty)

This is to Certify, That JAMES A. PILCHER

of North Powder State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Anthony Creek, a tributary of North Powder River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 1342 acres of land and domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 252; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1890 for 33 acres, from 1870 for 40 acres and from 1884 for 612 acres.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 3.54 sec. ft. from March 1st to July 1st and 1.68 sec. ft. from July 1st to October 1st of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 336 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water bereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 14 acres in NW4 of NW4; 9 acres in SW4 of NW4; Section Twenty-seven (27), 10 acres in NE4 of NE4; 22 acres in NW4 of NE4; 28 acres in SW4 of NE4; 21 acres in SE4 of NE4; 17 acres in NE4 of NW4; 122 acres in SE4 of NW4; Section Twenty-eight (28); 1 acre in SW4 of SE4; Section Twenty-one (21), Township Six (6) South, Range Thirty-eight (38) East of Willamette Meridian, in Union County, Oregon.
