CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES W. AND GRACE V. PLAHN

of Route 1, Carlton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Panther Creek a tributary of North Yamhill River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 13311 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 6, 1938

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26, Township 3 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 25
14.5 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 26
T. 3 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point marked by a 3/4" iron pipe on the North line of the said William L. Adams Donation Land Claim, said point being 691.36 feet North of and 4307.63 feet West of the Northeast corner of the R. R. Thompson Tract, said corner being marked by a 3/4" iron pipe set in County Survey No. 2708; Thence North 74° 19' 45" West along the North line of the said William L. Adams Donation Land Claim for a distance of 1569.66 feet to a point marked by a 3/4" iron pipe; Thence South 0° 01' 23" East for a distance of 4169.68 feet to a point marked by a 2" iron pipe; Thence South 76° 59' 26" East for a distance of 1822.85 feet to a point; Thence North 0° 01' 23" West for a distance of 2291.90 feet to a point; Thence North 59° 03' 00" West for a distance of 374.28 feet to a point marked by a 3/4" iron pipe; Thence North 43° 51' 30" West for a distance of 246.64 feet to a point marked by a 3/4" iron pipe; Thence North 40° 03' 30" West for a distance of 303.56 feet to a point marked by a 3/4" iron pipe; Thence North 18° 52' 00" East for a distance of 1349.49 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning and containing 148.787 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
