CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MRS. GEORGE C. FULLER

of Box 218, Amity, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Yamhill River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 13457 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 25, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.625 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12; and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre in Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
0.7 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 66
0.1 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
4.3 acres in Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
13.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 66
10.6 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 66
Section 12,
4.4 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 66
11.6 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 66
Section 13,
1.4 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 66
3.5 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 66
Section 14,
T. 5 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
