## **CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

## This Is to Certify, That F. M. VANDERZANDEN

of Route 1, Cornelius , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of East Fork of Dairy Creek and Drainage Ditch a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 13732 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 16. 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.73 cubic foot per second, being 0.56 c.f.s. from Cree. and 0.17 c.f.s. from Ditch,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 4; and NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 9, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
