CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **E. E. CHURCH, VIVIAN E. CHURCH, ROBERT W. CHURCH**
AND JAMES E. CHURCH

of Canyonville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 13814 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 13, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.61 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

17.1 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 43
15.9 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 43
6.6 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 43
1.2 acres in Lot 3 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
7.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$, as projected on D.L.C. 43

T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Part of the Donation Land Claim number Forty Three (43) of John Yokum in Section Twenty (20) Township Thirty (30), South, Range Five (5) West, described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of said claim, thence West Twenty (20) chains, thence North Forty Two and One Half (42.50) chains; thence East Twenty chains (20), to the East line of said claim; thence South Forty Two and One Half (42.50) chains to the place of beginning, containing Eighty Five (85) acres, also Lots numbered Two and Three (2) and (3) of Section Twenty (20) containing Twenty Two and 60/100 acres; Also the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter and the Lot Three (3) of Section Nineteen (19), containing Forty One and 80/100 (41.80) acres, all in Township Thirty (30) South Range Five (5) West of the Willamette Meridian, containing in the aggregate One Hundred and Forty Nine and 40/100 (149.40) acres, more or less, excepting therefrom the following described property: Beginning at a point in the East line of the John Yokum and wife D. L. C. number Forty Three (43) lying within Section Twenty (20), Township Thirty (30) South, Range Five (5) West of the Willamette Meridian, Two Thousand Six Hundred

and Three and $\frac{3}{10}$ (2603.3) feet North of the Southeast corner of said claim, said point being the intersection of the center line of the road to Riddle with the North boundary of the Pacific Highway, said point being marked by an iron rod $\frac{5}{8}$ " by 20" and from which a black oak 30" in diameter bears North Seventy Three (73) degrees, East One Hundred and Forty One and $\frac{8}{10}$ feet (141.8) and a black oak 30" in diameter bears North Twenty (20) degrees, East One Hundred and Forty Three and $\frac{6}{10}$ (143.6) feet; thence North on the East line of said claim Two Hundred and One and $\frac{7}{10}$ (201.7) feet; thence North 89 degrees, 44 min. West One Thousand Three Hundred Twenty (1320) feet; thence South Five Hundred Fourteen and $\frac{7}{10}$ (514.7) feet to a point in the North boundary of said Pacific Highway, said point being marked with a $\frac{5}{8}$ " by 24" auger bit and from which a concrete pedestal of the bridge approach marked C.S.B.O. bears South Ten (10) degrees, Twenty (20) minutes, West Nineteen and $\frac{6}{10}$ (19.6) feet and a concrete pedestal marked C.S.B.O. bears South Forty (40) degrees, Ten (10) minutes, East Twenty and $\frac{1}{10}$ (20.1) feet; thence North Seventy Six (76) degrees, Fifty Five (55) minutes; East along the North line of said Pacific Highway One Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Five and $\frac{6}{10}$ (1355.6) feet to the place of beginning, containing Ten and $\frac{85}{100}$ (10.85) acres more or less; Also excepting therefrom a strip of land Sixty (60) feet wide being Thirty (30) feet on either side of the center line of said road as surveyed over and across the Southwest Quarter of Section Twenty (20), Township Thirty (30) South Range Five West of the Willamette Meridian; Beginning at station 254+73 of the Pacific Highway Survey which station is approximately One Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty (1920) feet East of the Quarter corner which is common to Sections Nineteen (19) and Twenty (20) Township Thirty (30) South Range Five (5) West of the Willamette Meridian, thence running in a Southwesterly direction approximately One Thousand-Three Hundred Forty Seven (1347) feet to Station 168+20 of said survey which station is approximately Six Hundred and Five (605) feet East and Two Hundred Eighty-Five (285) feet South of the quarter corner which is common to Sections Nineteen (19) and Twenty (20) Township Thirty (30) South Range Five (5) West of the Willamette Meridian, excepting that portion already dedicated by public use as a county road. New Right of Way required being a proximately One and $\frac{85}{100}$ (1.85) acres. There being conveyed by the within description One Hundred and Thirty Six and $\frac{70}{100}$ (136.70) acres more or less, being situated in Douglas County, State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
