**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** EDWARD AND VIRGINIA BARTLETT

of Route 1, Box 252, Tigard, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Fanno Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 14675 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 12, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 13, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
Section 13,  
T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at an iron pipe in place at the recognized N. W. corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 13, T. 2 S., R. 1 W. of the W. M., and running thence N. 89° 50' E. 660.1 feet to an iron pipe in place; thence S. 0° 24' West parallel with the west line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 13 a distance of 392.3 feet to an iron pipe; Thence S. 89° 46' W. parallel with the south line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 13 a distance of 660.1 feet to a point in Fanno Creek on the west line of the said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 13; from which point an iron pipe bears N. 89° 46' E. 30.0 feet; thence N. 0° 24' E. along said west line 393.1 feet to the place of beginning, excepting right of way of the Oregon Electric Railway Company. Excepting any portion within the boundaries of roads and highways.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
