of Route 4. Box 102, Portland 22, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Kellogg Creek and unnamed spring a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

irrigation and domestic under Permit No. 11788 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 7. 1911

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second, being 0.015 c.f.s. for irrigation from Kellogg Creek and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic from unnamed spring;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE1 SW1, Section 6, Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W. N., as projected on Elisha Kellogg D. L. C. 54.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic in the NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, 1.2 acres in the NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, Section 6, T. 2 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

as projected on the Elisha Kellogg D. L. C. 54.

I land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Being a part of the Elisha Kellogg D. L. C. No. 54 in T. 2 S. R. 2 E. of the W. M. Clackamas County, Oregon and bounded and described as follows to wit: Beginning at a point in the South boundry of the Elisha Kellogg D. L. C. No. 54 in T. 2 S. R. 2 E. of the W. M. which point is 89° 41' E. 300 feet distant from the S. W. corner of said claim, running thence S. 89° 41' E. tracing the South boundry of said claim 150.00 feet; thence N. 0° 04' W. parallel with the West boundry of the Elisha Kellogg D. L. C. afcressid 933.90 feet to an iron pipe: thence N. 89° 41' W. 150.00 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 0° 04' E 933.90 feet to the place of beginning, containing 3.2159 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
